Discussion and possible action on minutes of January 19, 2016 meeting minutes.

Welcome was given to our new Senior Advisory Committee Member Pat Magdic.

Update on "Community Center to Civic Campus Transition Plan". Horner updated the committee on the 2016 Transition plan to help senior's awareness of the changes ahead in regard to the civic campus move to help create a less stressful outcome for them. She outlined a month to month strategy for 2016.

Update on senior sponsorship. Horner updated the committee on the 2016 year to date sponsorship totals. Senior sponsorship has already met and exceeded our yearly goals through Center of Attention ads and event sponsorship by local business.

Update on senior picnic 2016. Horner updated the committee on the theme and plans for the senior picnic to be held, Wednesday, July 27 at Village Park. The theme is "Breaking Ground for Senior's". Sponsorship \$\$'s from the canceled Rockathon will be applied to our entertainment and dining expenses for the picnic. Many senior businesses will be participating.

Senior Coordinator's Report – Horner reported on 2 successful dinner parties. February – Chinese New Year and April – Take Me Out to the Ball Game. Hamilton HS Drama was at the Community Center on April 21 to perform selections from their production of "Cinderella Enchanted". For the Mother's Day Event – "Language of Flowers", Monday, May 9 - Seniors made tea cup floral arrangements that were very popular. Local senior, Jan Staples taught us techniques. Lunch program continues to grow and is planning for many local summer festival themed lunches. Upcoming events to include a "Trustee Talk", Monday, May 23 at the Community Center, Green Thumb planting event at Village Park, Wednesday, June 8 and our next dinner party "Goodbye, Hello", Thursday, September 22 at the Community Center.

Director's Report – Snapp reported that the Weyer Park Equipment was moved to Grogan Park and a ribbon cutting ceremony will be held June 14 at 5:30 p.m. Megan Sackett has taken on a new management role in the parks on an interim basis. Due to the construction, the Community Center has been taking village water bills and library books for drop off and has exposed many seniors to the community center and what goes on daily for their age group.

Village Administrator Report – Mr. Smith reported on all upcoming village happenings and status of projects including Civic Campus and Main Street closure schedules. Planned move in date for Civic Campus is mid October. November elections will be held in the new building. No demo date yet for Youth Hall. Much new construction both commercial and residential was discussed. Meijer's will designate the Sussex Outreach Services as the recipient of its first "Simply Gives" gift card program for the Sussex location. Some discussion was held on local projects.
