SUSSEX YARD WASTE PROGRAM (Johns Disposal)  
Public Works Garage – N59W23525 Clover Drive

April 2 to October 29  
SATURDAY - 8:30 am – 12:00 pm

You must purchase yard waste stickers in order to dispose of yard waste at this site. Use your own bags. One sticker will be required per bag or container. You can purchase yard waste stickers at the Village Hall or Sussex Ace Hardware. \$1.25 each or 5 for \$5.00. **Yard wastes are defined as lawn clippings and leaves. Brush is defined as twigs and branches from trees and bushes less than five (5) inches in diameter. Tree stumps are not allowed.**

In addition to the Village's yard waste program, Village residents can participate in the Town of Lisbon compost site. **Village residents must purchase a "Compost Pass" from the Village Hall.** Village residents shall be entitled to drop off yard waste / brush and pick-up (at no extra cost) compost and/or wood chips from the compost site in the same manner as Town residents when the material is available.

- THE FACILITY IS FOR RESIDENTIAL YARD WASTE ONLY! NO COMMERCIAL USE IS ALLOWED.
- DO NOT BRING TRASH, JUNK, RAILROAD TIES OR CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS.
- NO TRUCKS LARGER THAN A PICKUP TRUCK CAN BE USED FOR PICK UP OR DUMPING OF MATERIALS.
- ONLY RESIDENTIAL USE TYPE TRAILERS CAN BE USED FOR PICKUP OR DUMPING OF MATERIALS.
- ONLY ONE VEHICLE AT A TIME WILL BE ADMITTED PER PERMIT.

**Yard wastes are defined as lawn clippings and leaves. Brush is defined as twigs and branches from trees and bushes less than five (5) inches in diameter. Tree stumps are not allowed.**

**Cost of pass - \$25.00**

**Replacement cost is: \$5.00**

Village residents must purchase a Pass from the Village and upon request; make said Pass available to the Town's staff on site. Village residents may be asked to verify the Pass authenticity with a driver's license to check the address. The Pass allows user access to the site until close of the compost site for that year.
