



New Garbage/Recycling Hauler

(This applies only to one- and two-family residences)

Johns Disposal Service has been selected by the Sussex Village Board as the new garbage and recycling hauler starting in January 2016. Collection will be automated using 96-gallon carts that will be provided to you by the contractor. This change to automated collection with Johns Disposal Service is saving you just over \$40 in 2016.

In mid December, Johns Disposal Service will deliver two 96-gallon carts — one for trash and one for recycling — to each resident served by the trash contract (single-family and two-family homes only). Collection using the new carts will begin January 4, 2016.

The switch to carts provides you with **single-stream recycling**. This means you can put all your recyclables into the cart, you will not have to separate paper from cans, glass and plastic, and you can recycle much more in 2016 than you can today.

What Items Can be Placed in the Green Recycling Cart?

Mixed Containers

- Aluminum cans
- Clean aluminum foil
- Tin cans
- Aerosol cans
- Empty/dried paint cans
- Glass bottles/jars
- #1-7 plastic
- Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons

Mixed Paper

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Books
- Mail
- School/office paper
- Brown corrugated cardboard
- Gray chipboard (cereal & shoe boxes)
- Brown paper bags

Shredded Paper

Please put in a secured clear plastic bag and place in the GREEN cart.
No other recycling should be placed in bags.



Why did we switch to automated collection?

The Village's contract was up and the Village bid the service, with the three major local companies all offering proposals. The results of those bids led to these savings. In addition, automated collection is becoming the industry norm.

Will my collection day change?

No. Collection days will remain the same as today.

- Homes north of Good Hope Road will receive collection on Mondays.
- Homes south of Good Hope Road will receive collection on Thursdays.

Trash will be collected every week and recycling will be collected every other week. Look for your collection calendar on your cart when it is delivered.

Do I have to pay for the carts?

The annual fee for garbage collection includes one trash cart and one recycling cart. If you would like additional carts, they can be rented from Johns Disposal. Additional trash carts are \$60/year and additional recycling carts are \$42/year.

How do I request additional carts?

What if my trash doesn't fit in the cart?

All of your trash needs to fit in your cart each week, but the cart lid does not have to be closed all the way for collection (i.e. a trash bag could be sitting at the top of the cart causing the lid to stick up and Johns will still collect your trash).

DID YOU KNOW

50% of the revenues earned from the sale of recyclables comes back to the Village to help pay for services. *The more you recycle, the less the recycling program costs you.*



What about large items?

One large item per month can be collected at no additional charge on the second week of the month. This includes items such as a lawn mower, a sofa or chair or an appliance. Special pickups of up to three large items are available with a \$40 fee and are scheduled directly with Johns Disposal.

Can I store my carts outside?

The Village does not restrict outdoor storage of the carts, but some subdivision associations may. Please contact your subdivision association directly to ask if it is permitted to store trash/recycling receptacles outdoors in your subdivision.

What about yard waste?

Yard waste will continue to be collected at the Public Works Garage (N59W23525 Clover Drive) on Saturday mornings from April thru October. Users must purchase yard waste stickers in order to dispose of yard waste at this site. One sticker will be required per bag or container. Residents can purchase yard waste stickers at the Village Hall or Sussex Ace Hardware. The sticker cost is \$1.25 each or five for \$5.

In addition, Village residents can drop off yard waste/brush and pick up compost and/or wood chips from the Lisbon Compost Site on Saturdays from 9 am to 3:45 pm and on Mondays from 4 to 7:45 pm. This site is open from April–November and is located at N80W25354 Plainview Road. (Lisbon may delay opening in early April if the site is too wet.) Those interested in using the compost site must purchase a Compost Pass from the Sussex Village Hall. The cost of the yearly pass is \$25.

Yard wastes are defined as lawn clippings and leaves. Brush is defined as twigs and branches from trees and bushes less than five (5) inches in diameter. Tree stumps are not allowed.

How do I dispose of tires?

Tire collection will occur at a cost of \$2/tire on a specified collection date once per year at the Public Works Garage (N59W23525 Clover Drive). Look for this date in The Courier or on our website next year.

What about Christmas trees?


The Village will continue to collect Christmas trees after the holidays at no additional fee.

Does Johns Disposal accept electronics?

Cart Placement

- The arrows on the lid of the cart must point to the street.
- Handles and wheels should face away from the street.
- The garbage cart should be placed within 2 feet of the street on one side of the driveway.
- The recycle cart should be placed within 2 feet of the street on the other side of the driveway.
- Please keep 6 feet of clearance between the carts and other objects, especially mailboxes and vehicles.
