

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Sussex Water Utility system, in the past, exceeded the standard levels of radium as set by the EPA of 5 picocuries per liter (pCi/L) in your drinking water. This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately. Sussex is producing treated water as of June 30, 2019. The DNR requires that we send you this notice. Recent water samples collected indicated radium amounts of: 2.22 pCi/L, 3.16 pCi/L, 4.56 pCi/L, and 1.44 pCi/L. The water is safe to drink and you do not need to seek an alternative source of water to drink.
